

East Ventura Community Council

The East Ventura Community Council is currently in need of officers so this valuable community service can continue. The council was formed in 1997 to provide information to citizens of Ventura who reside East of Victoria, mainly in Districts 4 and 5, and to give those citizens a voice with city government and service agencies. The officers needed include:

Chair: The Chair leads all meeting and sets the agenda in cooperation with the board. The Chair acts as the spokesperson for the council, and helps arrange for speakers at the general meetings. Approximate time commitment 2 hours per week, plus 1 two hour general meeting per month.

Vice Chair: The Vice-Chair performs the functions of the chair when the chair is unavailable. The Vice-Chair helps with membership recruitment. Approximate time commitment 1 hour per week, plus 1 two hour general meeting per month.

Treasurer: The Treasurer keeps the financial records of the organization, makes deposits and write checks for expenses. The Treasurer gives a report of the financial state at the general meeting. Approximate time commitment 1 hour per week, plus 1 two hour general meeting per month.

Term of Office: The officers serve for one year from January 1 to December 31 and are usually elected at the November general meeting.
